Inferential

1. Why did Luna wag her tail when Sophie hugged her?
(She knew that Sophie cared about her. / Luna felt safe with Sophie.)
2. Why did the vet hold out some food for Luna?
(The vet thought the food might help Luna to feel better when she was inside the clinic.)
3. Why did Luna look at the vet and wag her tail when they were outside?
(Luna knew that the vet wouldn't do an operation outside the clinic.)

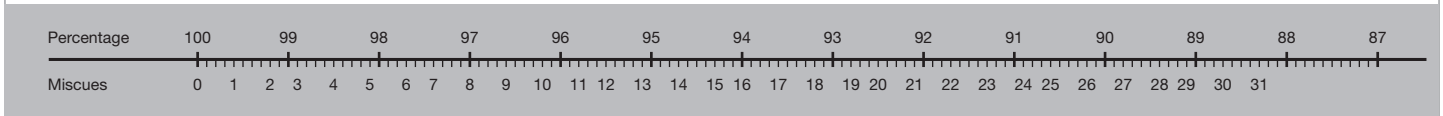
